WEST COVINA, Calif.—At its May 2016 meeting, the [Commission on Accreditation of Allied Health Education Programs](#) (CAAHEP) awarded initial programmatic accreditation to North-West College's [Surgical Technology program](#) at its Long Beach campus. The five-year accreditation followed a rigorous review process, including a self-study and two-day inspection of the Long Beach program.

"Receiving this distinction means we meet or exceed the standards set forth by CAAHEP, the premiere specialized programmatic accreditor in the field," explained Corporate Director of Compliance Ann Marie McGuiness-Leary. With the addition of CAAHEP accreditation, Long Beach Surgical Technology students are now eligible to take the Certified Surgical Technologist (CST) exam offered by the National Board of Surgical Technology and Surgical Assisting. Upon passing the exam, graduates are considered Certified Surgical Technologists.

"This latest accreditation demonstrates the College's continued commitment to offering excellent educational opportunities to our students.
